## Registration

## Confirmation

Confirmation of your registration will be emailed to you. If the class that you have applied for is full, you will be notified either by phone or by e-mail. Every effort will be made to place your sailor in another session or you can elect to be placed on a waitlist. All sessions are filled on a first-come-first-served basis.

## Session Cancellation Policy

If you wish to cancel, you must notify the Wayzata Community Sailing Center in writing at least two weeks prior to the start of the session to receive a refund (no e-mails or phone messages accepted). There will be no refunds given after that time. All refunds are subject to a \$30 cancellation fee.

## Weather/Illness Cancellation Policy

Classes will not be cancelled due to weather. When poor weather conditions occur, indoor sailing related activities are put into practice. Refunds or make-up classes will not be given due to weather or classes missed due to illness or injuries.

## Swimming Requirements

Parents or guardians must certify their child can swim. Children must be comfortable in and around water and be able to swim unaided and tread water. A swimming check-out, with life jacket on, will be given on the first day of class. This will allow the staff to assess the swimming abilities of your child. The staff will also teach on-the-water self-rescue techniques with a sailboat.

## Student Conduct

Students are required to follow the Wayzata Community Sailing Center code of good conduct. Respect for fellow students, safety, equipment, and the facility are paramount. When behavior problems occur, every effort will be made to resolve the problem. If the behavior problem is repeated or is of a serious nature, a WCSC staff member will contact the parent. There are no refunds for expulsion from WCSC for behavior problems.

## What Students Should Bring

- 1) Lunches are not provided. Please bring your own. Beverages are available for purchase.
- 2) Nutritious snacks are recommended. No high sugar please.
- 3) US Coast Guard approved life jackets are required.
- 4) Water compatible shoes and swimsuit.
- 5) Hat, sunglasses, sunscreen (apply before class) and water bottle.
- 6) Warm change of clothes, sweatshirt and towel.
- 7) Please mark everything you bring. A backpack is recommended to store gear.

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## Emergency Treatment Authorization

I/We the undersigned parent, parents, or legal guardian of \_\_\_\_\_, a minor, do hereby authorize and consent to any x-ray, examination, anesthetic, medical diagnosis rendered under the general or special supervision of any member of the medical staff licensed under the provisions of the Medicine Practice Act or a dentist licensed under the Dental Practice Act and on the staff of any acute general hospital from the State of Minnesota Department of Public Health. It is understood that this authorization is given in advance of any specific diagnosis, treatment, or hospital care being required but is given to provide authority and power to render care which the aforementioned physician in the exercise of his best judgment may deem advisable. It is understood that effort shall be made to contact the undersigned prior to rendering treatment to the patient, but that any of the above treatment will not be withheld if the undersigned cannot be reached.

## Release

The undersigned parent/guardian recognizes that an element of risk is involved in all water sports, including sailing. Therefore, to induce the Wayzata Community Sailing Center to accept his/her child into the Wayzata Community Sailing Center, the undersigned parent/guardian covenants and agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the Wayzata Community Sailing Center, its officers, directors, employees, and agents from any and all claims, losses, damages, fees and liability growing out of or in any manner related to injury to a person or damage to any property arising out of or in anywise connected with the operation of the Wayzata Community Sailing Center or any activities on or the use of any facilities or equipment of Wayzata Community Sailing Center.

## Certification of Swimming Skills

I/We the undersigned parent, parents, or legal guardian, do hereby certify the child enrolled can swim unaided for 40 yards and tread water for one minute.

## Parental Agreement

I/We understand that I/we are responsible for our child's or grandchild's behavior and conduct while at the Wayzata Community Sailing Center and will see to it that our child adheres to the program rules.
